

**PYC – Guardian  
Pune Snooker Ranking  
June 2014  
Rules and regulations**

1. The tournament will commence on Thursday 12 th June 2014 in the billiard hall of PYC Hindu Gymkhana, 766 Bhandarkar Road, Pune 411004.
2. The matches will be played on the knock out basis and best of 5 frames frames up to and including quarter finals. Semifinals and Final will be played over best of 7 frames.
3. The Fixtures will be Strictly adhered to. The Player reporting late but between 15 miminutes after scheduled time will have to concede one frame to the opponent.The player reporting later than 15 minutes of the scheduled time will be treated as given walkover to the opponent. The Clock of PYC Hindu Gymkhana Billiard Hall will be considered for this rule.
4. In case of any dispute the marker or player can consult the following members of committee (Subject to availability) .

Mr. Salil Deshpande , Mr. Arun Barve, Mr. Ashok Shetty, Mr. Vishal Malhotra,

Their decision or in their absence marker's decision will be final and binding on both the players. In such a situation the marker may consult the spectator/s also for important decision.

In case of any heated approach the committee members even other than the ones stated above may ask the individual/individuals to leave the billiard room without assigning any reason.

- 5 **Dress code** The matches will be played wearing formal Trousers. Collar T-Shirts and sports shoes will be allowed. **Jeans, Round neck T-shirts , Chappals, Floaters, Sandals will not be allowed.**

Collar T-Shirts and Sports shoes will be allowed.

The player should be descently dressed , he/she will be considered indescent if any part of his/her innerwear or skin will be visible when he/she is bending for his/her shot. This does not apply to normal body parts that are visible like arms or face.

- 6 In the event of player needing any reschedulement of match for any genuine reason it is at the sole descretion of the committee and opponent's consent and may be made iff the slot can be made available.

The reschedulement of match will be charged Rs. 250/- payable by the player needing reschedulement.

- 7 Mobile phones should be shut off before entering the billiard hall.
- 8 Smoking , Drinking and Eatables are not allowed in the billiard hall.
- 9 **The tournament committee reserves the right to modify any or many of the rules in the course of the tournament without prior notice.**
