

INFO PACK OF THE UNDER 25 SNOOKER CHALLENGE

1. All participants who are not above the age of 25 yrs can participate (born in 1988 and above can participate)
2. Entry fees will be Rs.500/-. Entry fees must be given along with a copy of the participant's birth certificate. If the entry fees are not paid or birth certificate not submitted, the participant shall not be allowed to play his match and shall be replaced immediately by one of the standby's.
3. Dress code: Smart casuals i.e normal jeans, collared T'shirts with sport shoes are permitted. No torn or patched jeans, low waist trousers, sandals, chappals or any kind of caps shall be permitted.
4. Format: 32 players shall be divided into 8 groups of 4 players each. The top 2 shall qualify for the knock out. All league matches shall be played over a best of 5 frames up to the quarter finals. Semi Finals and Finals shall be played over a best of 7 frames. There shall be a maximum of 3 foul and misses, after which the player can play from where the cue ball has come to rest, claim a free ball if it is or ask his opponent to play from where the cue ball has come to rest.
5. Prize money and trophies shall be given to the last 8 players. **However please note, all those who have to receive a prize must be present for the prize distribution ceremony, which will take place immediately after the finals. If a player cannot be present, a proper authority letter duly signed should be given to the person who will collect the prize. If the players or his duly appointed representative is not present, the prize shall be forfeited.**
6. The Draws and fixtures shall be posted on our website www.bsam.in. They shall also be put up outside the NSCI billiard room. A copy can always be downloaded from our site.
7. All players must be present for their matches 10-15 minutes before the stipulated time of the match mentioned in the draw. If a player is late by 5 minutes, he shall have lost the first frame. In case he is 10 minutes late he shall have lost the first 2 frames. In case he is 15 minutes late the player will have deemed to have lost the match. The watch of the venue shall be treated as the watch for deciding this issue. Matches shall commence from 10.am onwards and the slots shall be 10.am, 12.pm and 2.pm.
8. There shall be a snack stall outside the billiard room where players can buy what they like on purchase of coupons. No participant shall be allowed in the permit room and Maharaja restaurant.
