

SPL Rules & Regulations:

Match Format

League format: Each match would be a best of 5 fixtures.

- Fixtures to be played:
 - A. 15 Red Singles (Best of 3 frames)
 - B. 06 Red Singles (Best of 3 frames)
 - C. 15 Red Doubles (Single Frame)
 - D. 06 Red Singles (Best of 3 frames)
 - E. 15 Red Singles (Single frame -Sudden Death)
- Fixtures A, B & C have to be played as the first 3 fixtures of a match.
- The order for the first 3 fixtures will be determined by the toss.
- The team winning the toss will declare the first fixture (within 2 minutes)
- The other captain will decide the 2nd fixture post the 1st fixture (within 2 minutes)
- The remaining fixture will be played as the 3rd.
- The fourth frame has to be 6 Red Singles (best of 3 frames).
- The decider (Sudden Death) has to be 15 Red Singles.
- Chits will be exchanged for nominating players of every fixture (within 2 minutes)
- No player can play two consecutive fixtures.
- Any one player in a team can play twice in a match, however the second frame he decides to play has to be the Decider but not consecutive.
- 4 from each group will qualify for the quarterfinals.
- 4 different players have to play to win a match.
- 5 practice shots will be permitted for every player before play starts.

Foul n Miss Rule

In the 15 red snooker fixture – UNLIMITED FOUL & MISS.

In the 6 red snooker fixture - maximum of 5 foul n miss.

1. There will be **NOT** more than 5 consecutive FOUL AND A MISS calls at any one time.
2. After four consecutive FOUL AND A MISS calls, the referee will warn the offending player that should a FOUL AND A MISS be called again the following options are available to the non-striker:

- (i) play himself from where the balls have come to rest;
- (ii) ask his opponent to play from where the balls have to come to rest;
- (iii) place the cue ball anywhere on the table, but this option cannot be taken if play has reached the “snookers required” stage.

3. A player cannot snooker behind a nominated colour at any time.

In the 15 red doubles snooker frame – MAX 3 FOUL & MISS.

After that the opponent can either

1. Play from where the cue ball has come to rest.
2. Ask his opponent to play from where the cue ball has come to rest.

Dress Code

All players need to wear their Franchisee t-shirt.

No player will be permitted to play without him/ her wearing it.

Only formal trousers are permitted.

Formal Shoes are mandatory.

No slippers or open footwear will be permitted.

Track pants, three fourths and shorts will not be permitted in the banquet hall.

The tournament committee reserves the right to change, alter the date of the matches and will be the final authority on all matters and disputes concerning the LIC BSAM snooker premier league.
