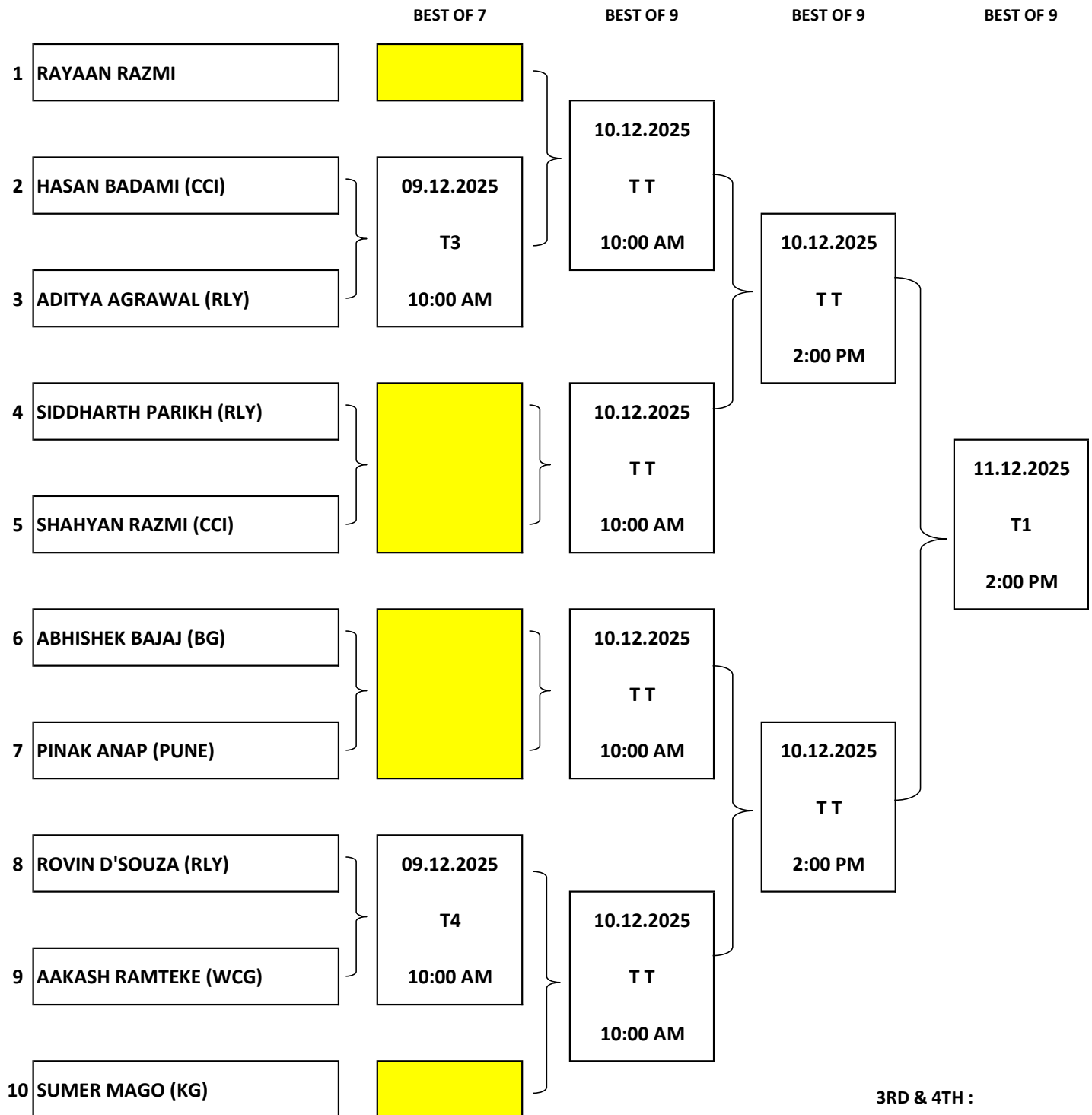

6 Red Snooker – Rules & Guidelines

Format: Matches will follow a knockout format,

Dress Code: All participants must be dressed in formal or semi-formal ;

- A collared T-shirt with formal trousers, socks, and formal shoes, OR
- A formal shirt with formal trousers, socks, and formal shoes.

Participants not adhering to this dress code will not be allowed to play.

Rules & Regulations:

This is a simplified version of traditional snooker played with only six red balls. While standard snooker rules apply, the following modifications are in effect:

1. Foul and a Miss:

- A maximum of five consecutive "Foul and a Miss" calls is allowed.
- After the fourth consecutive call, the referee will issue a final warning. If the foul continues, the opponent will have three options:

1. Play the shot from where the balls have come to rest.
2. Ask the opponent to play from the current position.
3. Place the cue ball anywhere on the table, except when the frame has reached the "snookers required" stage.

2. Snookering Restrictions:

- A player is not permitted to snooker behind a nominated colour ball at any time

3. All-Ball Tie Situations:

- In case of a tie where only colours remain, Foul and a Miss rules will still apply.

4. Snookers on Colours:

- If a player requires four or more snookers on colours (with no reds left), the frame is considered over.

Walkover Policy / Late Arrival Penalties:

Delay Duration Penalty

10 minutes 1 frame forfeited

20 minutes 2 frames forfeited

30 minutes 3 frames forfeited

40 minutes Match forfeited

- * Official match timing will follow phone-based time standards.
- * All players must check the official website for their match date and time well in advance.
- * Participants are expected to report at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled match time
- * No personal notifications will be sent. It is each player's responsibility to check the schedule.
- * Once matches are scheduled, no rescheduling will be permitted.
- * All decisions by the tournament committee will be final and binding.
