Entry Fee: £400 All entries are non-refundable after the closing date. Players are eligible to enter directly on an individual basis, providing that they are considered to be in good standing with all Cue Sport organisations at the time of entering and competing in the Q School.

All entrants must pay their entry fee into the bank account below and upload deposit slip (in English language) on the online entry form when applying, or by credit card charge on the entry form.

In the case of entrants contracted Covid-19 and are unable to travel within the time frame of the events. A legitimate lab results must be sent to bsat@me.com for the refund on the entry fee with your bank details as shown below. All relevant bank charges would be deducted accordingly.

Credit card charge: Credit card charge can be made on the entry form on the online system which will be available later. Entries can be submitted without payment being made for the time being. Please log in to check back for the credit card access and pay your entry fee by credit card respectively. Entries form will not be completed until the payment is fully made.

For credit card payment, please submit your entry form first and log back in to get access to credit card payment when it becomes available.

Max No of players: No Maximum.

Prize: Qualification for 2023/2024 & 2024/2025 World Snooker Tour. Any World Snooker Tour places awarded to players are subject to WST and WPBSA approval. In the event of a player qualifying for the World Snooker Tour more than once through a recognised qualifying route, the selection will be based on chronological order with the first event in the calendar counting as the qualifying place on the World Snooker Tour. The resulting available place will revert to a concession.

Players Qualifying: 1st, 2nd Events – two finalists from each event, making a total of 4 qualifying places. After the 1st event, the names of the successful players will be withdrawn from the 2nd events and those players who they were drawn against shall receive a bye into the next round of that tournament. Players who qualify for the World Snooker Tour will be required to attend a MANDATORY WPBSA induction day at the start of the season. Failure to attend may result in the player being refused entry to compete in World Snooker Tour events.

Number of Frames: 7

Seeding: There will be no seeding, Asian and Oceanian players falling off the World Snooker Tour from the 2022/23 season will be placed at random in the draw but seeded apart from one another in the opening rounds of the events so that they do not meet before the second round.

Round Structure / Draw / Format: Dependent on the number of entries. The draw for each tournament will be made as soon as possible after the closing date.

Q School T-shirt: Asia Oceania Q School T shirt can be ordered on the entry form at the price of £10 or 425 Thai baht each. Please add the cost of your required T-shirts to be paid together with the entry fee and select preferred size and T-shirt colour for your order.

Age Restrictions: There are no age or gender restrictions for entry to Asia & Oceania Q School, however, the WPBSA and WST reserve the right to refuse entry to any player under the age of 16 years of age as of 1 June 2023. Any player under 18 years of age as of 1 June 2023, must have their entry confirmed in writing and be accompanied to the event by a parent or guardian before competing.

Dress Code: Dress code will be dark trousers, shoes, collared plain shirt and waistcoat, **bow ties are required due to there will be live broadcasting on television.** No jeans or trainers are allowed.

Player logos to sell: 3 **World Snooker Logos:** 1

Only two logos are allowed on the waistcoat, all other logos are to be worn on shirt sleeves.
